 Even in the shade, the temperature in the car can still soar quickly to dangerous levels.

 Leaving the windows open has little effect on how hot it is inside the car.

The best thing to do for your pets when it's hot is to leave them indoors. The temperature inside a car reaches dangerous levels for dogs in just a matter of minutes, even with the windows cracked open.

What to do if your pet may have heatstroke

- Help lower your pet's body temp. by slowly applying cool water all over
- Place cool, wet towels on your pet's body
- Call your vet immediately to let them know you are on your way

What to do when you see a pet in a hot vehicle

- Call police or local animal control.
- Stay by the vehicle until help arrives.
- Alert the management of any nearby business, who could make a public announcement.
