Protect Your Pets From the Harsh Winter Elements

With temperatures plummeting and the snow piling up fast, it's important to prepare your pets for such harsh weather conditions. Pets, just like humans, can suffer from frostbite and hypothermia. Here are some tips for keeping your furry ones warm during these bitter cold months.

- I. Don't keep pets outside with no cover/ shelter from the elements. Heated blankets in dog houses help if you have access
- to an outdoor plug-in. Also be aware that only a handful of dog breeds can handle below freezing temperatures. Cold tolerance in dogs varies by coat thickness, fat storage, and health. Research your dog's breed if you are unsure of their cold tolerance.
- Make sure your pet has the proper outerwear. If you have a pet that is petite or has little to no hair, coats, sweaters and booties are a good idea to keep them warm while taking potty breaks. In severe cold temperatures frostbite only takes a few short minutes to settle in.
- Never leave your pet in a car during the winter months. Just like in the summer, pets trapped in cars during extreme temperature conditions can suffer from side effects. Make sure your car is always left running with the heat on when you have your pet waiting for you in a vehicle.
- 4. Bring all pets inside with you when temperatures drop to below freezing. Bring them in to ensure their safety during the bitter cold days this winter. They'll be happiest to be inside with you anyway.

Do you have any pets at home? I have a tripod cat and a tripod dog. Both were adopted from the humane society.




Longtime Residents in Need of a Home
